# Emma Donaldson **DIRECTOR/CHOREOGRAPHER**

Emma trained in Sydney in classical ballet, jazz, tap and contemporary dance from a young age. Her performance career took her around Australia, India and Taiwan on numerous corporate and theme park contracts.

Since moving to Dunedin in 2008, she has performed in various shows around New Zealand and also teaches classes in musical theatre, jazz, ballet and tap at Bennett School of Ballet and Jazz.

Emma made her musical theatre debut in 2014 as the choreographer of DKCM & Taieri Musical's *Mamma Mia!* Since then she has

choreographed many musicals around the Otago region including: Oklahoma, The Addams Family, Grease – The Arena Spectacular, Mary Poppins, Anything Goes, Priscilla Queen of the Desert, Wicked and Chicago. She has won Best Choreography at the Otago Southland Theatre Awards in 2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2022.

# Irene Mosley VOCAL DIRECTOR

On stage, off stage, at the piano, waving the baton or in governance; Irene's roots are firmly grounded in community theatre and its importance to both individual and community well-being.

Classically trained in piano and singing, Irene's first musical theatre involvement was in the 1981 South Otago Theatrical Society production of *Oliver* where she played the role of the Rose Seller. She has been musical director for several of their shows including *Annie* and *Wizard* of Oz.

Irene is currently on the Executive of Musical Theatre New Zealand and a trustee of the Otago Southland Theatre Awards (OSTAs) charitable trust, and was a judge for the OSTAs in 2018 & 2019. She sings in a Dunedin female choir and helped start a Brain Choir in Dunedin for people with brain injury or dementia.

Having seen the show in Sydney, New York, and London; the opportunity to be part of the team to bring this magic of *The Lion King Jr* to Mosgiel has been a dream come true. 
