50 Years of Taieri Musical

The Taieri Musical Society began in 1968 as the Outram Musical Society. This year our show *Ovation* celebrates 50 years of Musical Theatre on the Taieri.

It started with a group of Outram locals who got together with fellow like-minded people with an interest in singing, dancing and acting who produced a "revue" in the local Presbyterian Church Hall. The very small

stage was extended with planks secured on 44 gallon drums. The Sunday School room was the wardrobe and change room, the kitchen was the make up

room, the foyer the ticket office, and wooden forms complemented the wooden chairs.

The recollections of those who were involved with the society in those early years was the great sense of community camaraderie and the fun that was had both by those on stage and the team of wardrobe, stage hands, make up, and dressers, but also from the audience seeing their neighbours, work mates, and family performing. The scenery and costuming was always superb (as were the suppers) and the standard of performance though not always perfect was always enthusiastic. Full houses were the order of the day.

The revues were held each year until 1977 when the first show "Free As Air" was produced, which was followed by other shows. The society also changed its performance venue to the Coronation Hall in Mosgiel.

In more recent years the society has changed its name to the Taieri

Musical Society, and subsequently Taieri Musical, and has ambitiously and successfully produced modern musicals which have all reviewed critical acclaim.

There is not space in this programme to list the many people who over the past 50 years have gained their theatre experience through the Society's productions and who in turn have helped the Society to provide quality entertainment to the people of the Taieri and wider Dunedin.

Let Ovation be our tribute to all those who have been part of the past 50 years, and an inspiration for the next 50 years. The young people in this show are truly amazing and the oldies aren't too bad either.

DESTINY CARVELL






